BERTI is a group for people affected by brain tumours in any way.

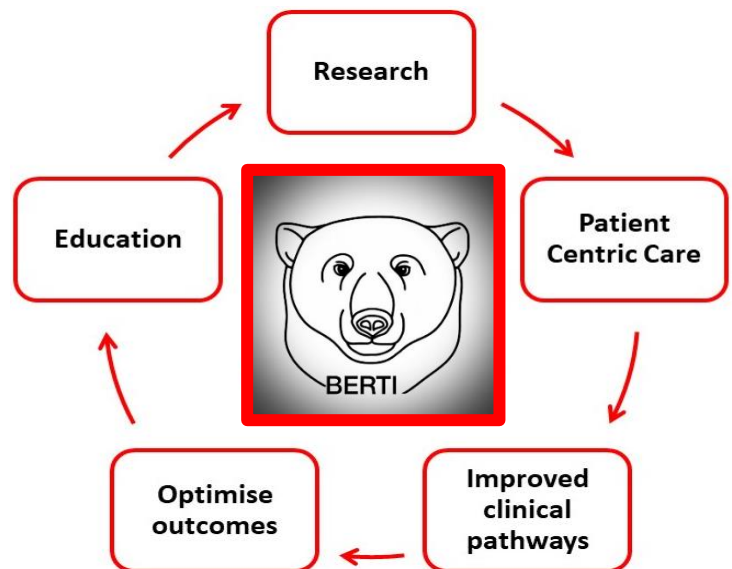
We include patients, friends and family, health professionals and researchers who are committed to improving the care of people with a brain tumour.
